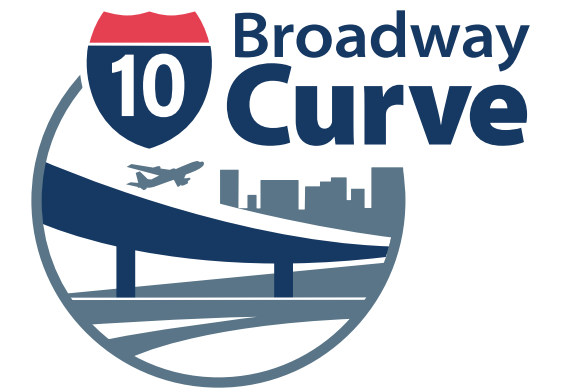


What to Expect During Construction *(and Where to Find Assistance)*



The Arizona Department of Transportation is about to begin a major project to rebuild 11 miles of Interstate 10 from Loop 202 (Santan/South Mountain Freeway) to Interstate 17. ADOT anticipates work will begin in summer/fall 2021 and will include reconstruction of the State Route 143 and U.S. Route 60 (Superstition Freeway) interchanges and add capacity to the freeway, all by the end of 2024.

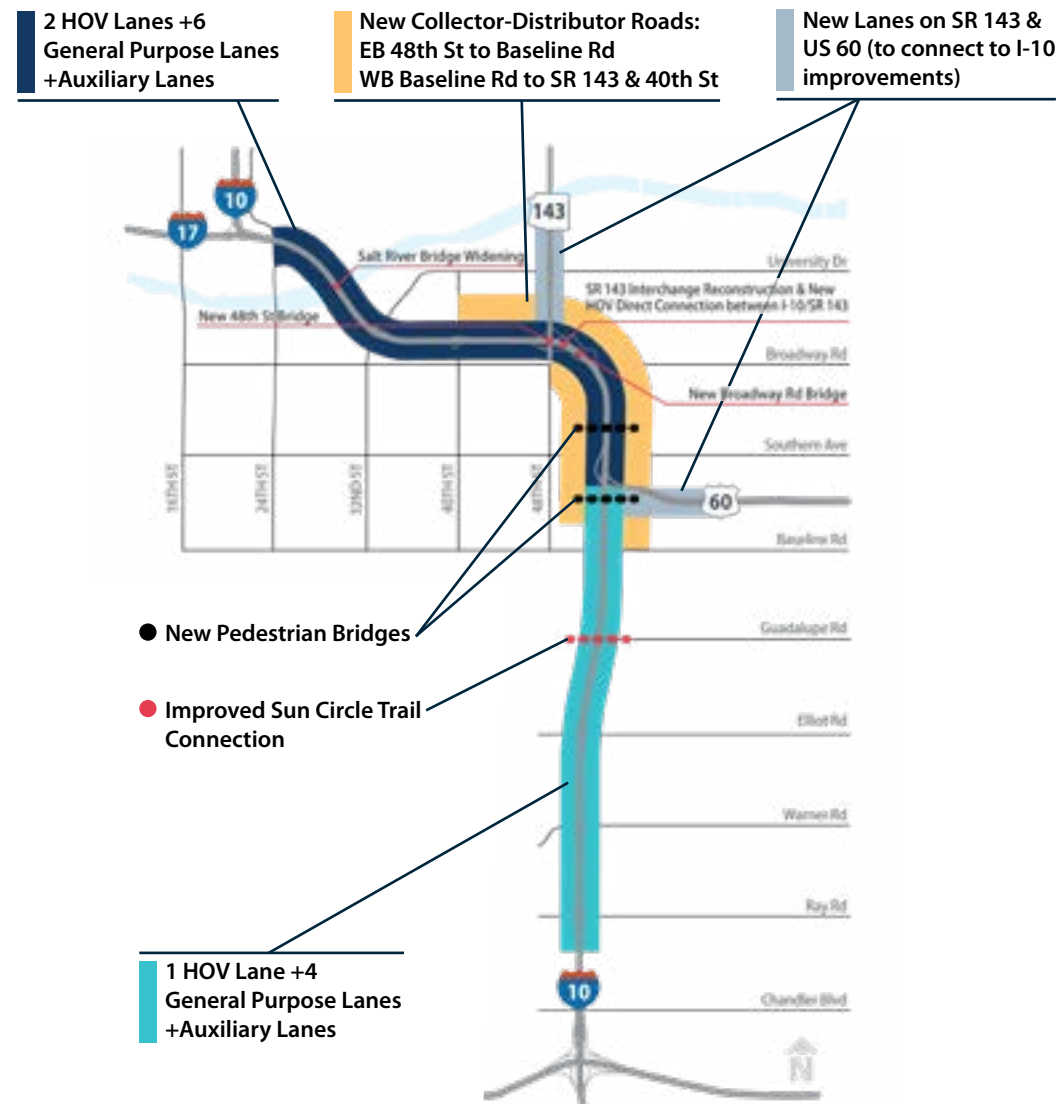
