



I-10 Maricopa Freeway and Broadway Curve Improvement Project

Loop 202 to I-17



Westbound US 60 ramp to westbound I-10 closed overnight, starting at 8 p.m.

Crews with the [Interstate 10 Broadway Curve Improvement Project](#) will be out tonight working in the area of Interstate 10 and US 60 (Superstition Freeway). The Arizona Department of Transportation urges you to **slow down** and **use caution** while the following restrictions are in place – and every time you drive in a work zone!

Westbound US 60 ramp to I-10 closed overnight Tuesday, Jan. 25

The westbound US 60 (Superstition Freeway) ramp to westbound Interstate 10 will be closed from 8 p.m. Tuesday, Jan. 25, to 4 a.m. Wednesday, Jan. 26, for striping removal. The US 60 HOV ramp will remain open during the closure. At the same time, the westbound US 60 on-ramps at Mill Avenue and Rural Road will be closed.

- **Northbound Detour:** Drivers traveling northbound on Mill Avenue and Rural Road can turn left onto Southern Avenue and travel westbound to Priest Drive, turn left onto Priest Drive and travel south to Baseline Road to access westbound I-10.
- **Southbound Detour:** Drivers traveling southbound on Mill Avenue and Rural Road can turn right onto westbound Baseline Road to access westbound I-10.
