

Guadalupe Road bridge over I-10 closed Sunday, May 1, and the weekend of May 6-9

PHOENIX – As part of the Interstate 10 Broadway Curve Improvement Project, crews will be closing the Guadalupe Road bridge in both directions over the freeway at times as work to widen and improve the bridge begins.

Closures are scheduled from 6 a.m. to 3 p.m. Sunday, May 1, and again from 10 p.m. Friday, May 6, to 4 a.m., Monday, May 9.

What's closed: Guadalupe Road will be closed in both directions between Pointe Parkway/48th Street and Calle Sahuaro.

Westbound Detour: Drivers on westbound Guadalupe Road should travel south on Avenida del Yaqui/Priest Drive to Elliot Road. Turn west on Elliot Road and north on 48th Street/Point Parkway to access Guadalupe Road west of the closure.

Eastbound Detour: Drivers on eastbound Guadalupe Road should travel south on Pointe Parkway/48th Street to Elliot Road. Turn east on Elliot Road and north on Priest Drive/Avenida del Yaqui to access Guadalupe Road east of the closure.

Improving the Sun Circle Trail crossing at Guadalupe Road is part of the I-10 Broadway Curve Improvement Project. The widened bridge will accommodate pedestrians, bicyclists and equestrians.

The I-10 Broadway Curve Improvement Project is identified in the Maricopa Association of Governments' Regional Transportation Plan, funded by a half-cent sales tax approved by Maricopa County voters in 2004 through Proposition 400. MAG identified the need for this project to reduce travel times on I-10 during peak hours; improve airport access; support ridesharing and transit; and prepare the region for future growth projections.
