This month marks the first full year of major construction activities on the Interstate 10 Broadway Curve Improvement Project. In July 2021, crews began removing the rubberized asphalt from I-10 and setting up the work zones. Also this month, phase one of the project was completed! You have likely seen some of the significant progress - and you can expect to see even more during phase two.

A New Record!

On July 9, workers installed girders for the new Broadway Road bridge over westbound I-10. At 180 feet and approximately one-half-inch long, these 17 girders are now the longest precast concrete girders in Arizona.



PHASE TWO: WHAT TO EXPECT

Phase two of four is now underway, and is anticipated to last through late 2023. Some of the work you can expect to see includes:

- Making roadway improvements.
- Coordinating utility relocation.
- Reconfiguring ramps.
- Constructing new walls.
- Widening the roadway.
- Building the Collector-Distributor (CD) roads.
- Widening bridges.
- Constructing new bridges, including the US 60 to I-10 bridges.

In addition:

- Crews reconfigured the I-10 westbound and eastbound travel lanes south of Baseline Road to support median construction at the Guadalupe Road bridge, as well as the future multiuse bridge over I-10 at the Western Canal.

- Workers will continue building the concrete block sound walls adjacent to I-10 between Elliot and Guadalupe roads.

CD Roads: Workers began forming the abutments for the new westbound CD road bridge over Southern Avenue. The abutments are the upright structures on each end of a bridge. Additional CD road work will occur in phase two. CD roads are being constructed along westbound I-10 from Baseline Road to 40th Street and along eastbound I-10 from 48th Street to Baseline Road. Decks on Deck: Construction of the new 48th Street and Broadway Road bridges over I-10 will also continue during phase two. In June and early July, crews successfully set the girders for both bridges, and are now preparing them for their decks (the part you will drive across). Placement of the new 48th Street bridge decks is set to begin later this summer.

Highway and Street Closures Continue

Open Again: Local 48th Street in Tempe! Following paving and lane striping, crews reopened 48th Street between 14th Street and Medtronic Way on July 10. Bridge and new ramp construction in the area will continue through the summer.
