Building Bridges

There is no shortage of bridge work underway throughout the project area.

At I-10 near US 60, crews are working on the foundation of the new Western Canal multiuse bridge. When completed and open, it will provide safe crossing over I-10 for pedestrians and cyclists. Another multiuse bridge is under construction at Alameda Drive. Enhancing pedestrian and bicycle connectivity is one of this project's goals.

Temporary on-ramp creates additional work space

At left: On Aug. 8, workers opened a temporary westbound I-10 on-ramp at Broadway Road. This temporary ramp shifts traffic north and east of the previous ramp to create more space for workers to continue building the Broadway Road bridge over I-10.

Highway Closures Continue into Fall

With extensive bridge work underway in several locations, plan for additional highway closures for the rest of this month and into fall, with the exception of the Labor Day holiday weekend when no closures are planned.

The closures are necessary to protect drivers and their vehicles during bridge construction. Crews cannot work on bridges over the highway with live traffic below.
