November is the perfect time to say thank you for your patience while construction of the [I-10 Broadway Curve Improvement Project](#) is underway.

We are happy to tell you that no full highway closures are scheduled during the holiday season. Some overnight lane restrictions are planned, but not at times or in locations that would notably impact drivers. State Route 143 ramp reconfiguration

In early November, drivers on northbound State Route 143 began using a new temporary ramp between Interstate 10 and University Drive.

This traffic shift allowed workers to begin building the new bridges that will eventually connect SR 143 to I-10. If your travel plans include using northbound SR 143 from westbound I-10, slow down and follow the directional signage.

Coming in 2023:

Broadway Road and 48th Street bridges set to open

Crews focused on placing bridge decks in October, so the new Broadway Road bridge and 48th Street bridge decks are nearly complete. Crews will now focus on tying the new bridges to the existing roadway. Workers plan to open the new bridges to


Guadalupe Road bridge widening progresses

In early November, crews placed the bridge deck to widen the Guadalupe Road bridge over I-10 and improve the Sun Circle Trail crossing for pedestrians, cyclists and equestrians. This bridge is also expected to open in 2023.



40th Street on-ramp to eastbound I-10 opens

Drivers who use 40th Street now have a new on-ramp to access eastbound I-10. In September, workers began reconfiguring the eastbound I-10 on-ramp from northbound 40th Street. In early November, workers opened this newly configured on-ramp and permanently closed the loop ramp that drivers who use southbound 40th Street had used to access eastbound I-10. Drivers who use southbound 40th Street now use a new left turn lane to access the new on-ramp to eastbound I-10.



Recognizing America Recycles Day: Nov. 15, 2022

November 15 was America Recycles Day, which raises awareness about reusing or recycling materials to reduce waste. What better day to highlight how the I-10 Broadway Curve Improvement Project team reuses and recycles construction debris throughout the work zone?
