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April 2023

Construction is going the distance for the [Interstate 10 Broadway Curve Improvement Project](#). With our "Ready to Rubble" event this month, we will say good-bye to the old bridges and make way for new ones.

Our main event: "Ready to Rubble!"

Earlier this month, crews opened the new Broadway Road bridge over Interstate 10. Workers opened the new 48th Street bridges over I-10 earlier this year, so they plan to remove the old 48th Street bridges and the old Broadway Road bridge April 22-23. The removal will require the following closures beginning the evening of Friday, April 21, through the early morning of Monday, April 24:

- Eastbound I-10 between State Route 51 and US 60.
- Westbound I-10 between US 60 and 32nd Street.
- Northbound 48th Street/SR 143 between Broadway Road and I-10.
- Southbound SR 143/48th Street between McDowell and Broadway roads
- Broadway Road in both directions between 55th and 48th streets.

SR 143 connections to I-10



Workers continue to construct the bridges that will connect SR 143 traffic to the high-occupancy vehicle (HOV) lanes on I-10.

In February, they placed the first set of girders. Each girder is more than 100 feet long and weighs approximately 88,000 pounds.

Crews also placed a second set of girders March 30 – April 1. When complete, the SR 143 to I-10 HOV bridge will have 10 piers and be approximately 960 feet long.

Long-term closures continue

Crews closed the westbound I-10 off-ramp at 32nd Street on Saturday, March 4, to reconfigure the ramp. Crews placed the new pavement and expect to reopen the ramp in late April or early May.

- The westbound I-10 on-ramp at 40th Street closed on Saturday, March 18. Workers removed the existing pavement and graded the roadway base in

preparation for paving. This closure is expected to last into May. To complete the ramp reconfiguration, southbound 40th Street is scheduled to be closed most weekends in April.

- The westbound I-10 off-ramp at Warner Road closed on Friday, March 31, to reconfigure the ramp. Workers expect this closure to last approximately three weeks. Drivers can use the off-ramps at Ray or Elliot roads instead.

Your questions answered

We receive hundreds of questions and comments through our Construction Operations surveys. Since the surveys are anonymous, we respond to a few of them in the monthly newsletters. Here's a question from last January's survey:

Will the Warner Road overpass be widened as part of this project?

The Warner Road overpass will not be widened as part of the I-10 Broadway Curve Improvement Project. The need for capacity improvements at the Warner Road interchange was identified in the [2017 I-10/I-17 "Spine" Corridor Master Plan](#) conducted by the Maricopa Association of Governments. However, funding for these improvements was not included in the scope of the I-10 Broadway Curve Improvement Project. The project scope does include widening the westbound I-10 off-ramp at Warner Road to accommodate a second right-turn lane onto eastbound Warner Road to reduce traffic backups. Although widening the Warner Road overpass is not included in the scope of this project, it could be included in a future project if funding is available.
