Additional Lanes Open

The Interstate 10 Broadway Curve Improvement Project opened new lanes in both directions on mainline I-10 in January. There are now six general purpose lanes and one High Occupancy Vehicle (HOV) lane in each direction between 24th Street and Broadway Road. However, work continues in the project area, including work to add a second HOV lane on I-10 between US 60 and I-17. This means closures and restrictions will continue through the spring. For closures, restrictions, detours and to #StayAheadOfTheCurve, visit the project website or download the free mobile app, The Curve, before you travel. While more lanes reduce congestion, please remember that the speed limit in the work zone is still 55 MPH.

Multiuse Bridge Update

In January, workers finished placing the decorative elements on the multiuse bridges, which are designed to look like prickly pear cactus fruit. The multiuse bridges over I-10 at Alameda Drive and the Western Canal each have a total of ten cactus fruit pieces. Each sculpture is an open, metal cylinder with a metal cutout drawing at the base, allowing sunlight to create shadow patterns on the bridge walkway. The sculptures are angled to provide a natural, varied arrangement for drivers and pedestrians alike. Each metal sculpture is approximately 8-feet tall and 4-feet around. The bridges are scheduled to open in late spring. The artwork was designed and funded by the city of Tempe. You can view a behind the scenes video on this artwork here.
